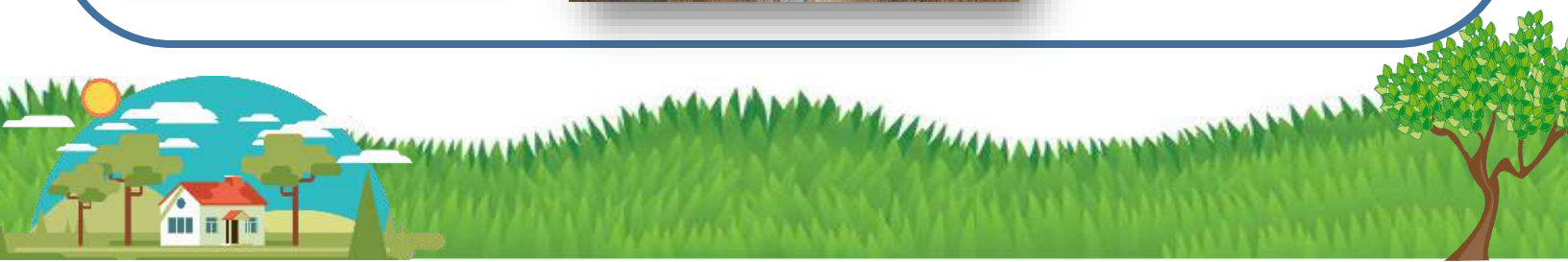
Butterfly Class
